

## **Wetlands, Greenways and Watersheds** **Environmental Program Funding Sources**

### **EPA Mid-Atlantic Wetland Program Development Grants**

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced the 2009 request for proposals to develop programs for wetland protection and development. Local governments and State Universities in Virginia are among the entities eligible for the funding.

### **Kodak American Greenways Awards Program**

The Kodak American Greenways Award Program provides small grants to stimulate the planning and design of greenways in communities throughout America. Many projects throughout Virginia have benefited from this program.

Grants may be used for a wide variety of activities. Generally speaking, the funds can be used for all appropriate expenses needed to complete a greenway project including planning, technical assistance, legal and other costs. While the awards will primarily go to local, regional, or statewide nonprofit organizations, public agencies may also apply.

### **Chesapeake Bay Small Watershed Grant Programs**

This program, administered by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, provides grants to local governments and organizations whose goal is to protect and improve watersheds in the Chesapeake Bay basin. Grants are awarded in two categories: project planning and design grants and implementation grants.
